3	Text fonts & layout are easy to read
2	<b><u>Illustrations:</u></b> <input type="checkbox"/> Picture of rock/mineral in natural form <i>AV only-also include a picture of rock/mineral in nonnatural form (i.e. what it gets made into)</i>
2	<input type="checkbox"/> Map showing where found <i>AV only- map is showing rock/mineral location in southern hemisphere</i>
5	<input type="checkbox"/> MLA format bibliography including at least 2 sources (alphabetical order, punctuation/order of information, hanging indent)
2	<b><u>Thinking map:</u></b> <input type="checkbox"/> The name of the rock/mineral as the center title
5	<input type="checkbox"/> adjectives to describe how to identify the rock/mineral if you were to find it (correct spelling)
3	<input type="checkbox"/> identifying the type of rock (metamorphic, sedimentary or igneous) OR mineral's chemical composition (formula)
3	The frame should include a <u>sentence</u> that describes how rock/mineral is used.
nothing	Authors name in lower right corner (so I can give you credit)
