

Group Phylum Project Requirements for the Poster

To earn 80% (B-) on the poster you must include:

- 1. Name of assigned phylum as a title
- 2. a common name that can be used to describe the phylum
- 3. names of group members on front of poster
- 4., 5. list/ define/ describe the common characteristics of the phylum
- 6. how do members of this phylum reproduce (if asexual - which form of asexual reproduction)
- 7. where do these live?
- 8. how catches or obtains food?
- 9. how is the animal organized? (i.e. do these animals have nervous system, respiratory system, digestive systems, bones & muscles, brain), skin?
- neatly created & colorful

To earn more than 80% credit, you may include additional information options-

- 10. According to conventional dating, when did it first appear in the fossil record? (You may use the geological period--for example, the lower Permian, upper Cambrian, etc.)
- 11. Section titled: Which one of these does not belong? Have 3 pictures of representative animals from the phylum & one that is NOT part of the phylum
- 12. special or unusual appendages or body parts? (name, illustrate & describe the purpose of the unusual body part)
- 13. identify at least two example classes within your phylum (use a thinking map)
- 14. name, describe & illustrate examples of animal in this phylum that are in/around California
- 15. Two interesting, weird or unusual facts about your phylum
- 16. Mini-quiz section about your phylum asking 3 questions (must include way for self-correction or be able to find answers on the poster)
